You will also support the Drama department by running workshops and preparing students for other performances within the school. You will work closely with the Director of Drama to put together a schedule of lessons and begin the process of becoming an LAMDA assessment centre.

Experience and Qualifications

- Outstanding knowledge of the LAMDA specification
- Excellent communication, organisation and administrative skills
- An extensive range of theatrical knowledge of both contemporary and classical play texts.

It would be an advantage if the successful candidate has:

- Previous history of a high pass rate, merit or above
- Knowledge or experience of setting up a LAMDA assessment centre
- LAMDA qualification minimum Level 3 or above
- Has experience of leading showcases for parents and students.
